OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Central Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme - obtaining of nominations.

The undersigned is directed to invite the attention of all Ministries/Departments of the Central Government to para 19.3 of the Group Insurance Scheme wherein it has been provided that if a member of the scheme has a family as defined in the General Provident Fund (Central Services) Rules, 1950, at the time of his making nomination, he shall make such nomination only in favour of a member or members of his family. The foot-note below Form No.7 prescribed for nominations requires that where a Government servant who has no family makes a nomination, he shall specify in Col.5 that nomination shall become invalid in the event of his subsequently acquiring a family.

2. The implications of the above provisions are clear enough that if a member of the scheme has a family, he can nominate only a member or members of his family and any nomination given before marriage of the Government servant becomes invalid after marriage.

3. All Heads of offices are requested to re-check and obtain nominations from the Government employees, wherever necessary. It shall be the responsibility of the Head of the office to keep a watch and ensure compliance with the provisions of the Group Insurance Scheme.
